

# Unit planner: What's the commotion on the ocean?

2 weeks

<b>Lead Subjects: Literacy, D&amp;T, Art,</b> <u>National curriculum subject</u> <u>Writing</u> Pupils should be taught to: Plan and write within a given structure - fact-file, diary, newspaper report, poem etc Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech Plan writing by discussing writing that is similar. Plan by discussing and recording ideas. Draft and write by recording ideas in a given structure. Spell words correctly from the year 3 literacy appendix. Proof read own work to check for errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation. Evaluate and edit own work using Purple Polishing Pens to make corrections. Read work out loud to a group or the whole class with fluency and accuracy. Write using a legible joined script. <u>RE</u> See SACRE document <u>Computing</u> Recognise familiar forms of input and output devices and how they are used. Make efficient use of familiar forms of input and output devices. Understand that computer networks enable the sharing of data and information. Understand that the internet is a large network of computers and that information can be shared between computers. Use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private. Recognise acceptable behaviour online. Use simple search technologies and recognise that some sources are more reliable than others. <u>PSHE</u> Pupils should be taught to: Learn why and how rules and laws that protect themselves and others are made enforced.
