

## Unit planner: Why do we celebrate festivals?    Year 2   2 Weeks

<b>Lead Subjects: RE, Literacy, Art/DT</b>		<b>Starter: WOW day. Each teacher to hold a different event linked to festivals. (RE Unit 1: Who celebrates what and why?) Outcome: Christmas Performance.</b>			
<p><u>National curriculum subject</u> <u>Writing</u> Pupils should be taught to: Write for different purposes to develop positive attitudes toward and stamina for writing. Consider what they are going to write before beginning by planning or saying out loud what they are going to write about. Write down ideas and/or key words including new vocabulary. Use the correct grammar and punctuation, for year 2 expectations, in their writing. Make simple additions, revisions and corrections to their own work using a purple polishing pen. Use peer and self-reflection to make additions, revisions and corrections.
